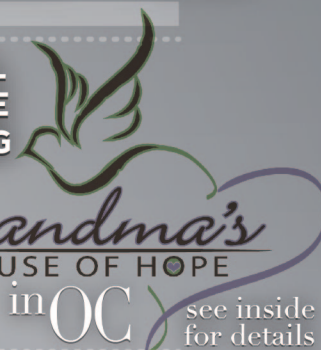

The Heart of PSNA

Our Park Santiago 2nd Annual Concert in the Park is a benefit for Grandma's House of Hope. We are collecting food donations of non-perishable cans, boxes, bottles, etc. Last year we collected over 6 HUGE bins of food & this year with your donations we hope to surpass that.

They will also be accepting monetary donations if you'd prefer, & checks are gratefully welcomed.

Let's show them what Park Santiago can do to benefit families in need!! Collection bins will be supplied at the event including a donation site at the Grandma's House of Hope booth on the baseball field.

Grandma's House of Hope is a non profit charitable organization that provides compassionate and uplifting care for uniquely challenged women in crisis & hungry children in Orange County. Their children's program "Nana's Kidz" is aimed at identifying children enrolled in the free lunch program at school who are living in homeless conditions, such as motels. The program provides weekend and summer meals for the children when the school cafeteria is closed. Starting in 2007 with 10 kids in the program, they have grown to an enrollment of 345, serving over 300,000 meals to disadvantaged children in 6 Orange County cities, including Tustin, Orange & Anaheim. Due to the downturn of the economy, donations of all kinds have been short this year, yet the need for the program increases - Statistics show that over 86,000 children live at or below poverty level in O.C. Donations from communities like Park Santiago go a long way to help GHH feed hungry children-every little bit Helps!
