

The November 6 PSNA meeting will feature our annual election—plus a pizza party, raffle, and perhaps free giveaways from local businesses! Details are still being worked out. Meanwhile, if you'd like to run for an office of any type, you merely need to be a neighborhood resident, show up at the meeting and state your intention to run. Offices include four executive board members (president, V.P., secretary and treasurer) plus twelve quadrant representatives. Most, if not all, neighborhood quadrants will have at least one uncontested Quad Rep seat open for 2014. Quadrants are determined by the intersection of Santiago and Santa Clara. For example, if you live south of Santa Clara and east of Santiago, you live in the PSNA southeast quadrant.

We will generally meet the first Wednesday of every other month, 7 p.m., at the Lawn Bowling Clubhouse. The November meeting is no exception.
